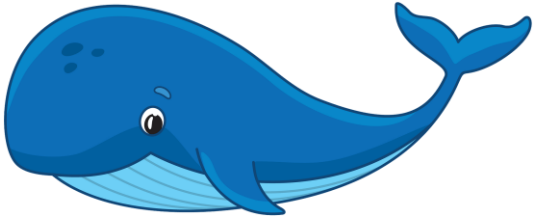
Water pollution is causing significant damage to our environment and ecosystem. We should take immediate action to prevent it. If we all work together, we can make a difference!

# Endangered Animals: Blue Whales

The blue whale is the largest animal in the world. It can grow up to thirty metres long and can weigh up to a hundred and fifty thousand kilograms. It lives in all oceans except for the Arctic. As of 2023, its population ranges from ten thousand to twenty-five thousand individuals. Sadly, it is listed as ‘endangered’ under the Endangered Species Act due to many different threats such as ship strikes and commercial whaling activities.

Blue whales are endangered because of commercial whaling activities. People hunt them for their meat, skin, bones, baleen and fat to make food, soap and cosmetics which are





sold at high price. This leads to blue whales having a harder time finding mates and thus lowering the already low reproduction rate even more. This also leads to ecosystem being unbalanced, giving some sea creatures a lower chance of survival since they rely on the whales to live.

Apart from whaling activities, ship accidents are also responsible for the loss of blue whales. The waters are getting busier since there are more and more ships sailing around. However, whales and porpoises use echolocation to find food and mates. But most importantly, detect threats because blue whales are very sluggish. The sounds of motorized marine transportation are loud enough to disrupt echolocation. It disables their ability to detect danger and making them accidentally ram into ships and







thus killing them. Another type of ship accident is fishing, or more precisely, trawling. Fishermen hoping to catch lots of fish attach a very large net to their boat and pull it along the way while the boat moves. This type of net accidentally traps whales and covers their blowholes. Hence, the whales suffocate due to lack of oxygen.



Blue whales will go extinct unless we act against it. Fishermen should stop trawling fish because many other sea creatures get caught and die. Sailors should check their surroundings while they sail to avoid any whales heading in their direction. People should stop buying whale products like whale meat, soap and cosmetics so that no more whales will be harmed intentionally ever again.

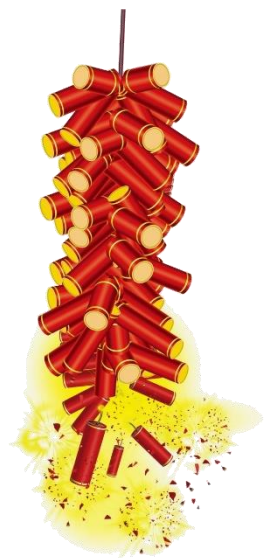
Hello! I am a student from Class 6E. I want to introduce Chinese New Year to you. It is the most important festival in China and people love to celebrate it with relatives and friends.

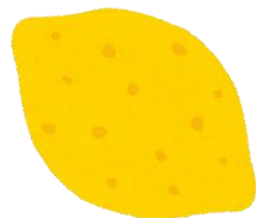
# 檸檬

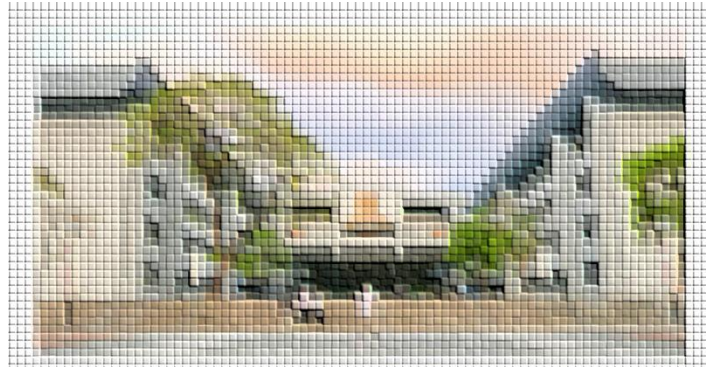

# 檸檬

**檸**檬，令人愛不釋手。它在歐洲從十五世紀中期的意大利城市開始種植，在1493年被人帶到了海地島，再傳到世界各地。

檸檬是一種含豐富維生素C的水果。它披着黃澄澄、鮮豔奪目的外衣，外形像一個橢球、一隻眼睛。檸檬的外皮凹凸不平，像樹皮一樣粗糙。它的果肉多汁，當你切開檸檬，它的酸氣味立即撲進你的鼻子。檸檬的果肉像透明一樣，一咬下去，那酸酸甜甜的味道令人面容扭曲，但又令人難忘。過了一會兒，你也會忍不住咬它，品嚐它酸酸甜甜的味道。



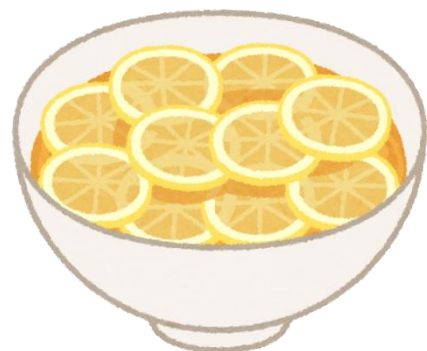
檸檬有很多用途。美國克利夫蘭醫學中心列出檸檬可以幫助消化。檸檬汁的酸有助促進消化，因為酸有利於分解食物，所以人體才會

有那麼多胃酸。胃酸會因年紀增長而減少，檸檬酸特別能夠促進胃酸分泌。用餐後喝檸檬水，除可助消化外，也能促進植物性的鈣、鐵、類黃酮素吸收，真是一舉兩得。



檸檬不單能幫助消化，還能食用，例如用來沖調檸檬水。檸檬富含維生素C和維生素P。每升檸檬水中含有501.6毫克的維生素C！這些維生素C是很好的

抗氧化劑，能增強身體免疫系統的反應能力，間接增強免疫力。這些維生素C也能活化細胞，抑制黑色素形成，促進傷口癒合。我們將檸檬切片或榨汁泡水喝，有美白潤膚的作用，但過量的維生素C會令人產生噁心的反應，並引發胃部不適，因此「少吃多滋味，多吃壞肚皮」啊！



檸檬除了食用，還能清

潔。我們可以在有油垢的地方撒上鹽巴，然後把檸檬朝有油垢的地方來回塗抹，便可去除油垢。這樣做不但可以去除油垢，也不用擔心化學物質殘留的問題，用來保障家人的健康。檸檬也能清潔銹漬、茶漬、咖啡漬等。相比市場上售賣的其他產品，檸檬的清潔和消毒作用好很多。它可以使房間和家用器具光亮如新，對環境毫無傷害。所以，用檸檬來清潔是一個很好的主意。



檸檬本來是一種好普通的水果，但他的好處卻有很多，我們要注意一些有關食用檸檬的禁忌，例如：檸檬不能和海味一起吃、檸檬和牛奶相剋、檸檬不宜與胡蘿蔔同食。由此可見，雖然檸檬含有大量營養，但我們要適可而止，避免吃太多而傷身體啊！
